The Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma is the center of a Sovereign Nation with inherent powers of self-government recognized as such by treaties and legislation, located in Perkins, OK. In the Ioway language, we call ourselves Baxoje (Bah Kho-je), meaning “People of the Grey Snow”. The story of our name has been handed down from generation to generation. The Ioway (descendants of the Oneota) lived for the majority of its recorded history in what is now the state of Iowa, therefore, the state of Iowa takes its name after the Ioway people. After The Treaty of 1836 assigned a portion of our Ioway people to a reservation in Nebraska and Kansas, some Ioways moved to Indian Territory in Oklahoma, dividing the
